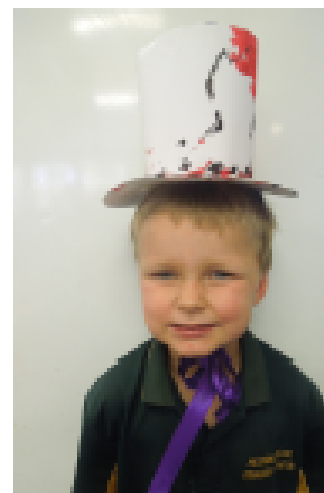
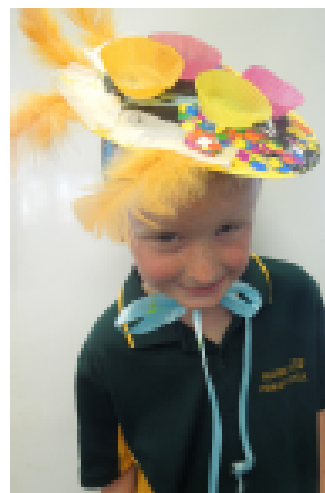
LUCKY LAST!!!

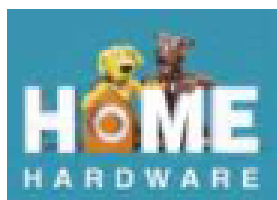
