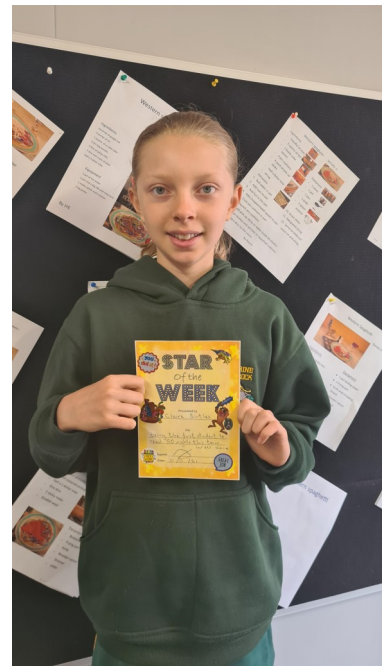
## IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

- ⇒ Saturday 11th December – Christmas Concert and Awards Night commencing at 6 pm

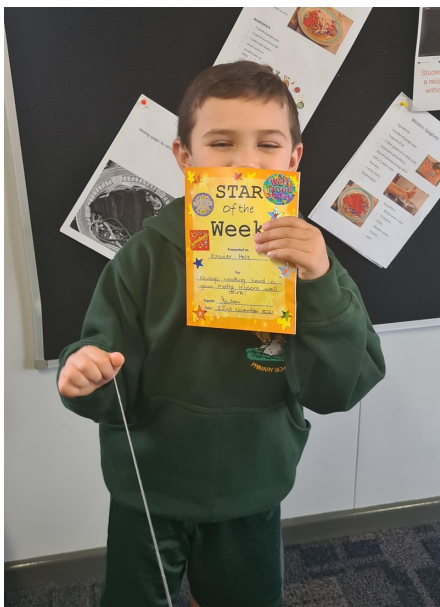

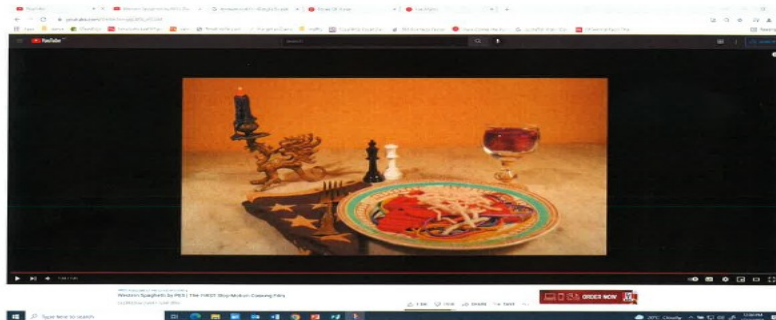

#### Ingredients

#### Intrusions

1. Boil water in pot

- ◆ Wool/ string

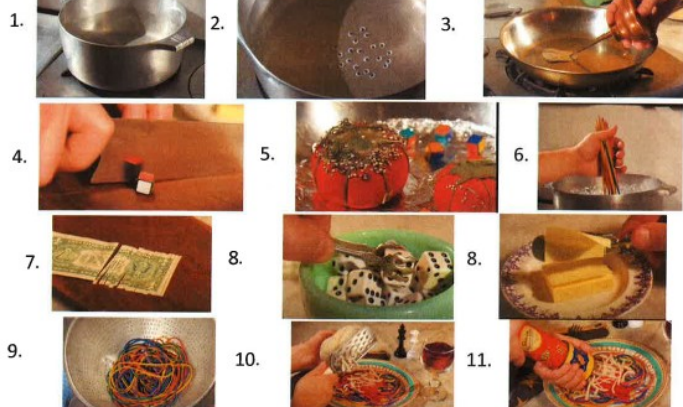
### Equipment
