IDEAS FOR HOT LUNCHES-MONDAY'S AND WEDNESDAY'S

Ham, Cheese & Pineapple Muffins

Ingredients

- 2 1/2 cups self raising flour
- 1 tablespoon sugar (optional)
- 200g ham, finely chopped
- 1 cup tasty cheese, grated
- 1/3 cup chives, chopped
- 1 1/4 cups milk
- 1 egg
- 60g butter, melted
- 410g can crushed pineapple, drained
- 1/3 tasty cheese, grated (extra)
- 1 tablespoon chives, chopped (extra)

Instructions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 180°C, fan forced.
- 2. Grease a 12-hole muffin tray or use a non-greased silicone tray and set aside.
- 3. In a large bowl, add flour, sugar, ham, cheese, chives, milk, egg, butter, mix to combine.
- 4. Gently fold through the pineapple.
- 5. Spoon mixture evenly into muffin tray.
- 6. Bake muffins in oven for 10 minutes or until golden and cooked through.

7. Sprinkle tops of muffins with remaining cheese and chives, continue cooking for a further 5-8 minutes or until cheese melts.

8. Rest in tray for 5 minutes, before transferring to a wire rack to cool completely or serve warm.
