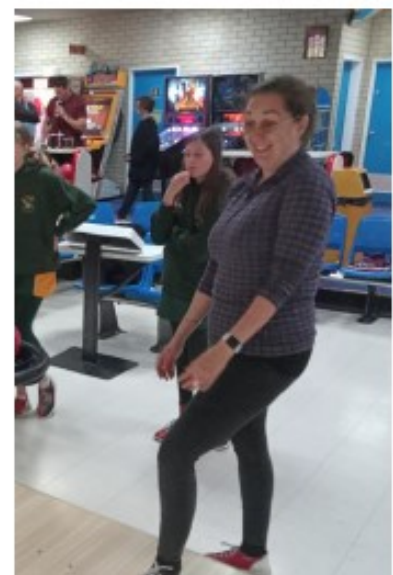



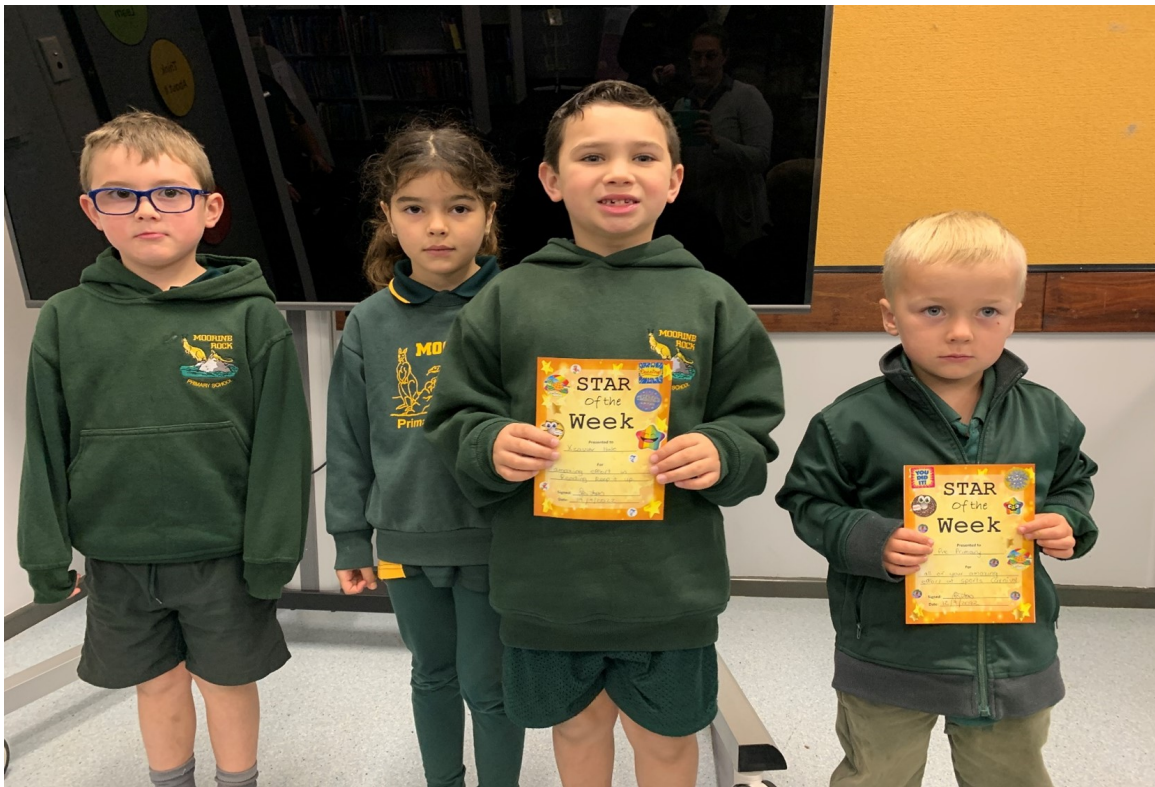
Thursday fortnightly in Terms 3 and 4
