We have been very productive in our Junior Room this week!

In Maths we have been learning about patterns. We have been creating patterns with our body movements in dances, with counters and beads, and even drawing and colouring patterns in our books.

## FROM MR SMITH

My name is Paul Smith, the kids know me as Mr Smith. I am taking the Pre-primary to Year 4 on Fridays. We will have Maths period 1, then a STEM (Science Technology Engineering and Maths) class period 2. In STEM in term 1, we will focus on biological science. The pre-primary began with a investigation into how birds make nests, they wandered through the surrounding bush looking at nests and collecting materials to make their nests. They then went and made the nests in the art room.

The year 3 and 4's studied how animals adapt to their environment. They focused on the thorny devil shown below.



After recess the year 3 and 4's did science with a focus on how animals camouflage themselves. They found out about the thorny toad, its camouflage and its ability to squirt blood from its eye. Which they then showed to the younger students through a presentation. An image is shown below.
