

Our last science experiment, Rainbow in a jar, didn't quite work out how we wanted it, so we will be trying it again and changing how we do it for our next combined science lesson.






# FROM OUR SENIOR ROOM WITH MS MELIS






The seniors also had a great time being creative and making Rocky Road and Chocolate Bark. Students then created a procedural text on how to make the Rocky Road.
