FROM OUR SENIOR ROOM WITH MISS HONG

As I reflect on Term 2, I think about all the wonderful learning and development that took place. Over the last couple of weeks, the Senior students have been learning about Aboriginal stories and learning about the Stolen generation, this has been connected into Visual Arts and Literacy. Students have spent time having meaningful conversations, while we use storybooks to elicit questions and comments about what Reconciliation looks and feels like.

In HASS, students have continued to learn about technology and change over time. They brought in "old" items from home, comparing them to current objects. Students were very engaged trying to figure out how to use a rotary and flip phone (T9 texting).

For Design, students have been focused on learning about boat building, we have been discussing buoyancy and experimenting with objects that sink and float. A big congrats to all students who submitted their artwork to the Yilgarn Agricultural Society to see who will have their drawing on the program's front cover.

That is a wrap for Term 2, see everyone in July for another engaging term of learning and growing!


