The students brought a teddy to school and created a story about how their teddy injured themselves to the triage nurse. Once they saw the nurse they then went and saw the doctor who gave them a treatment plan for their teddy. Below are some of their stories.

### Felix and Mr snake:



My snake was riding a bike and he did a big jump and tried to do a double back flip and landed on his head on the second flip and shattered his neck and there was blood everywhere.

The Doctor recommended a cloth held on to stop the blood, surgery on his neck and a bandage/ neck brace and rest.

#### Dustin and Mr Broccoli:

Mr Broccoli got thrown into the wall and broke his arm.

The Doctor recommended a cast and bandage on his arm and rest.

### Nikolai and Koala:

The Doctor recommended a blood test and bandage on his arm and possibly surgery depending on the blood test results and rest.
